The address given in the 1891 census was 1, Holt Street Buildings, Wrexham. From historical accounts of Wrexham at the turn of the 19th century, this was one in a terrace of properties lying somewhere between the current indoor market and the roundabout by the swimming baths. It seems to have been a fairly 'seedy' area of the town with open sewers. The properties were demolished in the late 1930s as part of Wrexham's slum clearance programme.

William Henry Marshall is listed as an artist on various documents. Some of his paintings still exist. One is shown on the web site.
